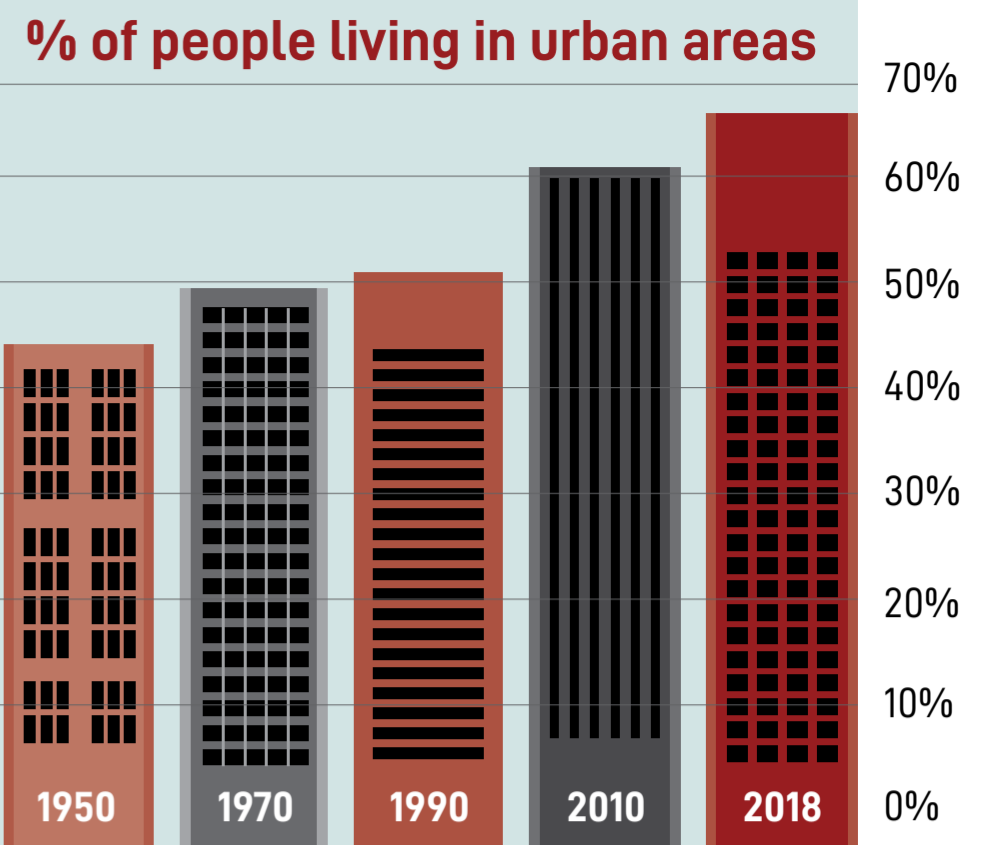

of South Africa's population live in the City of Johannesburg

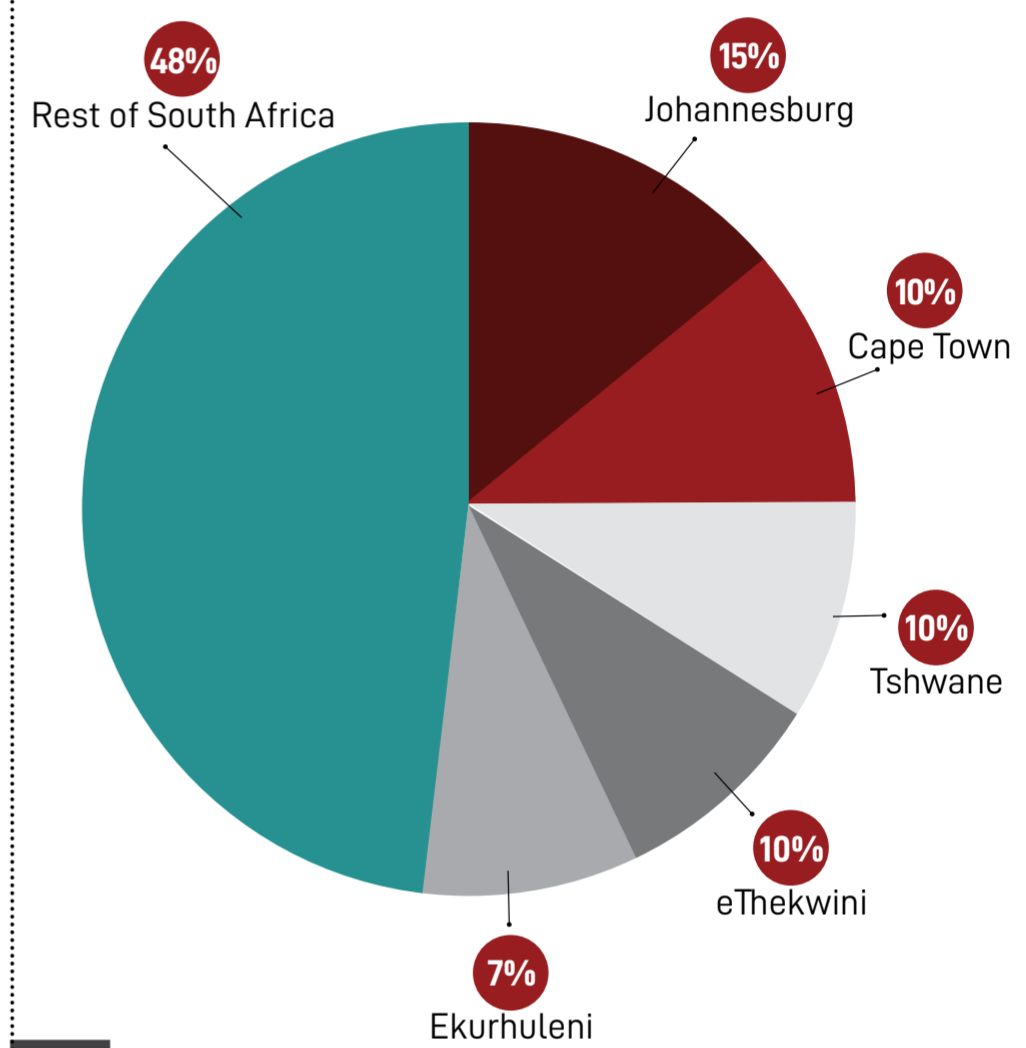


44,5% of all **employed South Africans** live in the 5 biggest cities

South African commuters spend on average 84 minutes commuting per weekday. **This places South Africa in the top 10 longest commutes by country**
